PURPOSE:	To obtain a urine specimen free from contamination

POLICY:

Teaching is an important key to the patient understanding of the cleaning and collection process. Instruct the patient on the clean catch urine specimen collection procedure using the Patient Instruction Sheet and check for patient understanding.

PROCEDURE:

- 1. Explain to patient the importance of following the specimen collection procedure so that accurate results can be obtained.
 - a. Instruct patient on procedure as follows:

Instruction for males:

- i. Wash hands with soap and water, rinse and dry.
- ii. Expose the penis, retract the foreskin (if not circumcised), and wash the end of the penis with soap towelette.
- iii. Rinse with saline towelette.
- iv. Void a small amount of urine into the toilet, and then collect a portion of remaining urine into the specimen container. The cup should be held to avoid contact with any skin and clothing. Keep the fingers away from the rim and inner surface of the container.
- v. When voiding is completed, close the container, wash hands, and give container to clinic staff as instructed.

Instruction for females:

- i. Wash hands with soap and water, rinse and dry.
- ii. Open all towelettes and specimen container and place them on a nearby clean surface. The cap of the specimen container should be placed upside-down, keeping the fingers away from the rim and inner surface of the cap.
- iii. Sit comfortably on the toilet seat and swing one leg to the side.
- iv. With one hand spread the labia folds apart and keep them spread during the cleansing and collection of the urine specimen.
- v. WASH the area from which urine is passed. Use one soap towelette, to wash gently, wiping only from front to back between the folds of skin. Repeat with a second soap towelette.
- vi. RINSE. Rinse with one sterile saline towelette. Use the front to back motion.
- vii. VOID a small amount of urine into the toilet, and then collect a portion of the urine into the specimen container. The cup should be held to avoid contact with any skin and clothing. Keep the fingers away from the rim and inner surface of the container.

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- viii. When voiding is completed, close the container, wash hands, and give container to clinic staff as instructed.
- b. Request feedback from the patient to determine patient's understanding of the collection procedure.
- c. Affix a patient label on the urine specimen container.
- d. Transport specimen to lab with the requisition form.
- e. If specimen collected for culture, refrigerate specimen immediately.

Patient Instructions for Collecting Clean Catch Urine Specimens

To get the best possible results, follow these instructions carefully

Female Patients

- 1. Wash hands with soap and water, then rinse and dry.
- 2. Wipe perineal/vaginal area with soap towelette front to back.
- 3. Repeat with second soap towelette front to back.
- 4. Rinse with saline towelette front to back.
- 5. Void small amount of urine into toilet and then collect into cup.
- 6. Do not touch inside of cup with skin or clothing.

Male Patients

- 1. Wash hands with soap and water, then rinse and dry.
- 2. Wash the end of the penis with soap towelette.
- 3. Rinse with saline towelette.
- 4. Void small amount of urine into toilet and then collect into cup.
- 5. Do not touch inside of cup with skin or clothing.
