Laboratory Client Update

To Our Valued Providers & Staff:

We have changed the process for urine collection and transport for the Gonorrhea, Chlamydia, and Trichomonas testing at Salem Health Regional Laboratory. <u>Urine samples no longer need to be</u> <u>transferred to transport tubes on-site.</u> Urine samples can now be collected in sterile urine cups and held in the <u>refrigerator</u> and need to be submitted to the lab within <u>24 hours</u> of the collection date & time. <u>Sample</u> <u>must remain refrigerated at 2 to 8 degrees Celsius.</u> The <u>original sterile sample cup</u> can now be sent to the lab without having to transfer the urine into the transport tubes. <u>This process becomes effective on</u> <u>October 2nd, 2023.</u>

What this means for ordering and collecting:

If only a Vaginal Pathogens by DNA Probe (aka Wet Mount) is needed a <u>vaginal swab</u> will need to be collected using the <u>BD Affirm VPII Collection kit.</u> (See collection information attached) If only a CTNGT or CTNG is needed a vaginal swab (self-collect or clinician) will need be to be collected using the <u>BD Molecular Swab Collection kit.</u> (See collection information attached) If both a Vaginal Pathogens by DNA Probe (aka Wet Mount) and a CTNGT or CTNG tests are wanted, then a vaginal swab will need to be collected using the <u>BD Affirm VPII Collection kit</u> (for Vaginal Pathogens by DNA Probe) and a vaginal swab will need to be collected using the <u>BD Molecular Swab Collection kit</u> (for the CTNG or CTNGT).

Urine Collection:

The urine patient collection for both males and females remains the same.

The patient should not have urinated within the last hour. Collect the first 20-60 mL of urine in a sterile, **preservative-free cup.** Label with the PID and date & time of collection. Samples can be held in the fridge and submitted to the lab within 24 hours of collection and remain refrigerated at 2 to 8 degrees Celsius.

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Laboratory Personnel or Designee:

The old kits containing the transport tubes for urine samples are to be collected by couriers from the various sites.
