This highly engaged group are members of the Longs Peak Hospital Medical Staff allowing for important multidisciplinary review of malignant cases before and after therapy treatment. Pathologist participation guarantees the most appropriate molecular and immunohistochemical testing is performed and continuity of care is preserved.

All UPS pathologists are board certified in Anatomic Pathology and two are also board certified in Clinical Pathology. They are closely affiliated with the University of Colorado Pathology Department for consultation and additional tissue stains.
