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## 24-hour Urine Specimen Collection Patient Instructions

## Do not urinate directly into the 24-hour urine container.

Urine should be collected in another clean container and then carefully poured into the 24-hour collection container.

## To collect a 24 hour urine specimen:

- 1. Follow you physician's directions regarding food, drink, or medications before and during the collection.
- 2. Empty bladder completely on awakening in the morning and discard this urine specimen.
- 3. Record the date and time under "start" and begin the test (Example: 08/15/05 @ 7:00 a.m.).
- 4. ALL urine passed during the rest of the day and night for the next 24 hours must be poured into the container. (Note: Container must be refrigerated during collection.)
- 5. Make final collection the next morning at the same time the test was started and record the time and date under finish.
- 6. Take the 24-hour urine specimen to the laboratory as soon as possible.
