Re: **Reference Laboratory Change for Pediatric Lead Testing**

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Effective immediately, all pediatric lead samples will route to ARUP (rather than Children's Hospital of Philadelphia). In order to facilitate this, the Lead Pediatric Microtainer with Hemoglobin and Hematocrit (LEADPED) will be inactivated. This change has come at the request of the performing laboratory; given an instrumentation challenge, the testing pathway will be reactivated when their testing resumes.

If lead testing is needed, one of the following two lead orders will work:

1. Lead(Blood) – preferred sample is a Royal blue (K2EDTA or Na2EDTA) or tan (K2EDTA)
2. Lead, Whole Blood Capillary – requires a Lavender Microtainer (EDTA)

If a hemoglobin/hematocrit is required, then a CBC should be ordered. One lavender top Microtainer will be sufficient for testing.
