Re: New Lupus Anticoagulant and Antiphospholipid Testing and Reporting

Orders and results related to lupus anticoagulant and antiphospholipid testing are being updated to reflect the most recent guidance from the International Society on Thrombosis and Haemostasis. We have included additional decision support on the orders and the results. Anticoagulants can interfere with testing and questions for these have been added to the affected tests.
