

Respiratory PCR Testing Collection Guide

All Tests Require UTM

(universal transport medium)



Test	Collection Instructions
Expanded Respiratory	Nasopharyngeal Swab:
Pathogen Panel	 Hold or cradle the patient's head and tilt it back gently. Gently pass the small tipped nasopharyngeal swab up the nose and move back towards the nasopharynx. Note: When you feel the back wall, gently angle the swab down into the nasopharynx. Rotate the swab on the nasopharyngeal membrane about 3-5
Core Respiratory Pathogen Panel	seconds.4) Remove the swab carefully and place the swab in the UTM vial and snap off the swab at the notched site on the swab. Throw away the shaft in a biohazard container. Place cap on the vial and tighten.
Community COVID/Flu/RSV	5) Place a patient label on the container and put the time and date of collection and your initials.
COVID/FLU/RSV BCH	Nasopharyngeal Swab (see above)
	OR
	Nasal Self-Collection:
	1) Wash hands or use hand sanitizer.
EMPLOYEE COVID/FLU/RSV BCH	2) Remove the swab from the package – do not touch the soft end with your hands or anything else.
	3) Insert the soft end of the swab into your nostril no more than $\frac{3}{4}$ of an inch into your nose.
	4) Slowly rotate the swab, gently pressing against the inside of
	your nostril at least 4 times for a total of 15 seconds.
	5) Gently remove the swab, and using the same swab, repeat with the other nostril.
	6) Place the swab in the sterile tube and snap off the end of the
	swab at the break line, so that it fits comfortably in the tube.
	7) Wash hands or use hand sanitizer.
	8) Place the tube containing the swab in the biohazard bag and seal the bag.
