Instructions:

- TEG availability: Monday-Friday 8 am 9:30 pm, weekends 8 am 3:30 pm
- Please call the lab at #5295, 30 minutes before sending the sample (instrument calibration).
- In addition to normal procedure for drawing labs from a CVL, please be sure to clamp any other lumen infusing heparin.
- The specimen must be WALKED to the lab and handed directly to the technician.
- Do NOT place specimen on ICE.
- Do NOT tube the specimen and do not place the specimen in any container in the lab.
- <u>Rejection criteria</u>: wrong tube type, insufficient sample, clotted sample, mislabeled sample, sample sent via pneumatic tube, sample sent on ice, sample older than 2 hours
