



# Pathology

The pathology department at Dayton Children's is committed to providing timely diagnostic results from tissue and cytology samples removed from our patients. The department offers immediate diagnostic information to help our surgeons during complex operations. The department will receive a piece of tissue, usually in formalin, process the tissue and create microscope slides for the pathologist to read. The pathologist will make a diagnosis and send a copy of the report to the surgeon and family physician. The pathology report will then determine the course of treatment for the patient. The Dayton Children's Pathology Department processes approximately 5000 surgical and 200 cytology cases per year.
