

Stool, Feces

Collection Procedure

- 1. Collect specimen in a clean bed pan or use a stool collection container placed between the toilet seat and the bowl.
- 2. Do not submit feces contaminated with urine or toilet water.
- 3. Immediately transfer specimen into the appropriate preservative per the <u>Fecal Collection</u>, <u>Preservation and Transportation Chart.</u>

Note: Only loose or diarrheal stools are recommended for routine bacterial culture. Formed stool, stool from children <2 years of age, and stool from patients tested within the past 12 days, will not be accepted for *C. difficile* testing.
