Subject: Changes to laboratory testing for PCR testing for Bordetella Pertussis

- In efforts to decrease turn-around time and provide extended testing coverage, Realtime PCR for *B. pertussis*, previously located in the molecular laboratory (Shapiro 3), will now be performed in the microbiology laboratory (Purple 4)
- Testing will continue to employ the *Bordetella* insertion sequence IS481 gene
- There are no changes to EPIC orders or collection requirements
- Testing will now be performed between the hours of 7am- 10pm with expected turnaround times available between 2-4 hours after receipt of the specimen in the microbiology laboratory
