	PLTND – Prolactin Diluton, hook effect
	<ul> <li>Due to updated methodology, a hook effect has not been demonstrated up to 30,000 ng/mL.</li> <li>This this test is no longer warranted. Please use Serum Prolactin (PLTN).</li> </ul>

## Body fluid white blood cell count - Effective 2/7/23

- To be consistent with Clinical and Laboratory Standards Institute recommendations, body fluid white blood cell count will be reported as **total nucleated cells**.
- This will include all body fluid specimen types as well as CSF.
