

Properly Label Your Laboratory Tubes

Fashion Do's

Label Correctly

- 1. Ensure the label is not faded, smudged or damaged.
- 2. Line up the patient label against the tube label with the name toward the top of the tube.
- 3. Keep the tube window visible.
- 4. Keep the barcode straight and flat.
- 5. Smooth the label around the tube.
- 6. Extra labels go in the outside pocket of the biohazard bag, not inside the bag.



Why Do Looks Matter?



Properly labeled tubes improve turnaround time, safety and patient/staff satisfaction.



Incorrect labeling wastes time and money and stops lab equipment, causing delays.
