



UNITYPOINT HEALTH - MERITER LABORATORIES TEST ANNOUNCEMENT Group A Strep Molecular

Starting immediately, mandatory questions along with a comment will be added in EPIC when ordering a Strep Group A Molecular test. These questions, listed below, concern the patient's drug allergy status and need for susceptibility testing:

- Does the patient have a history of severe IgE-mediated allergy to penicillin, amoxicillin, or beta-lactams?
- Run sensitivities?

If the first question is answered yes, the second question will cascade to be answered. If the patient does not have a severe IgE mediated allergy, sensitivities will not be performed. Additional information can be found in the comments section of the Molecular test, as seen below:

Resistance to penicillins and cephalosporins has not been reported in S. pyogenes (group A Strep). For patients unable to use a beta-lactam, sensitivities may be requested for clindamycin and macrolide using the order buttons above.

If the Strep A PCR result is Positive and the second question is answered yes, a susceptibility test will be reflexed and performed:
