	HPVREF	New Answer Choice	HPV Reflex Regardless of Diagnosis. If high risk HPV positive, reflex to HPV 16, 18/45 genotyping. Provider is responsible for ordering in accordance to current ASCCP guidelines.
Reflex HPV High Risk (ASCUS or LSIL Pap results).	RHPVHR	Stays the Same	Reflex HPV High Risk (ASCUS or LSIL Pap results).
Reflex HPV High Risk in younger women (21 to 29 yrs) with prior abnormal Pap/biopsy results.	RHPVAP	Obsolete Answer	
No HPV DNA reflex.	NOHPVR	Stays the Same	No HPV DNA reflex.
