# **Collection of a Specimen for Sputum Culture**

Your physician has requested that you collect a sputum sample for laboratory studies. This sample is obtained by collecting the mucous brought up from <u>deep</u> coughing (saliva is not acceptable).

- 1. If you wear dentures, they should be removed and your mouth rinsed with water immediately before you collect the sample.
- 2. You have been given a sterile cup for each sample needed. If you need a sterile cup please visit any of our laboratories and we will be happy to supply you with one.
- 3. Only one specimen should be collected per day. *Example*: If you physician orders a culture x3, 3 separate specimens should be collected on 3 consecutive days.
- 4. An early morning specimen is preferred for the best result but is not required. The specimen should be collected before eating.
- 5. The specimen must be kept at room temperature and transported to the Medical Office Building #4 or Saint Rita's Medical Center Outpatient Express within 1 hour of collection. (Specimens that have not been transported to the laboratory within 1 hour of collection will be rejected.)
- 6. Inform the receptionist when you sign in that you have a specimen which needs to be transported to the Laboratory immediately.
