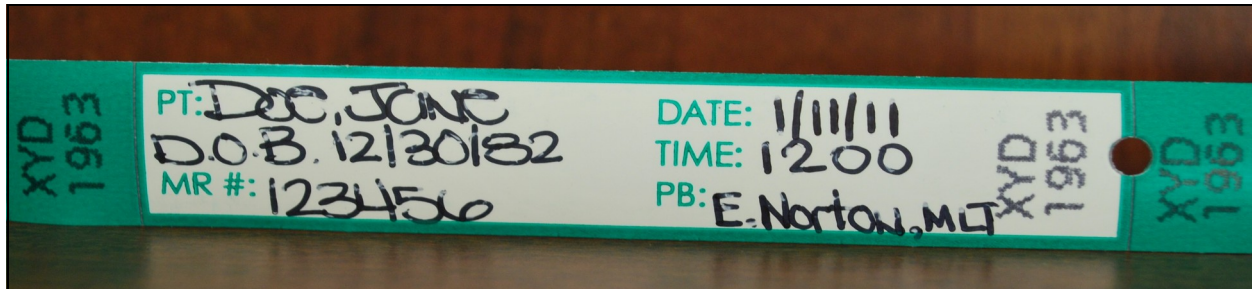
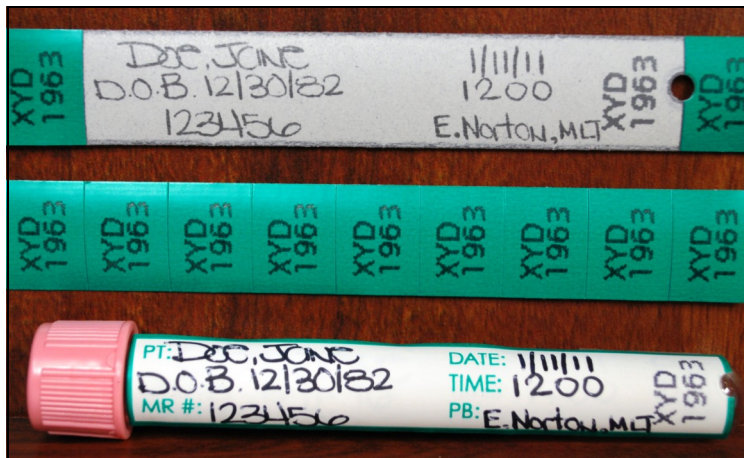


# Type and Screen & Crossmatches



Use a green typenex band. The patient must be banded at the time of draw at the patient's bedside. The following information is required to be on the band: Patient's first and last name (spelled correctly), medical record number and/or date of birth, date and time of draw, first initial and full last name of person drawing.



Once all of the information is on the label and you have double checked that all of the information is correct, peel label off and place it on the pink top tube that you have drawn. Place the band on the patient's wrist and cut off the tail end of the stickers. Send the labeled specimen and tail end of the stickers to the lab.



Some patients may be drawn up to 7 days prior to their surgery if they meet our criteria and sign a verification form. You may put their typenex band inside a plastic sleeve like the one shown above.

**Please check with blood bank at 9227 before cutting off any typenex band.**
