What is changing?

Effective **April 26, 2022** the Hypercoagulation Panel will be updated to include only tests that are run in-house at the NYP/WC special coagulation laboratory. This modified panel includes: Activated Protein C Resistance (APCR), Protein C activity, Protein S activity, Free Protein S antigen, Antithrombin III activity, Lupus Anticoagulant Panel (Diluted Russell Viper Venom Time with reflex to Silica Clotting Time) and a coagulation interpretation. Please note that Hexagonal Phase Phospholipid has been replaced with the Lupus Anticoagulant Panel.
