What is this message about:

Effective immediately, there will be a tube type change for the ARUP send-out Quantitative G6PD enzyme test (Lab code: LAB4901).

Why is this information important:

Dark Green Lithium heparin tubes (pictured below) are the preferred collection tubes for ARUP send out Quantitative G6PD enzyme test (Lab code: LAB4901). This change will be reflected on the printed specimen label.

NOTE: The green sodium heparin and light green (mint) plasma separator tubes are not acceptable tube types for this assay. If your department needs tubes ordered, please reach out to our logistics department at 212-746-0670.
