

UPDATE: EBV Viral Load Testing offered at the NYP/WC Molecular Pathology Laboratory

What is this message about:

NYP/WC Molecular Pathology Laboratory will no longer perform joint testing of samples using the previous Qiagen EBV Viral Load Test with the new FDA-cleared Roche Diagnostics Epstein-Barr Virus (EBV) Viral Load Test that was launched on March 3, 2025.

What we need from you:

Collection requirements will remain the same – one dedicated White Plasma Preparation Tube (PPT).

Baselining of results can be performed upon request until September 3, 2025.

Detailed description of the new changes:

Having results from both tests allowed for baseline comparisons for two important changes:

- 1. Unit change from copies/mL to IU/mL
- 2. Larger dynamic ranges from 200 to 400,000 copies/mL to 35 to 100 million IU/mL.
