

## **Stool Collection**

- 1. Collect stool in a clean, dry container. A washed butter dish or a specimen container provided by the lab may be used. Do not let the specimen touch the toilet water.
- 2. For babies it is acceptable to line a diaper in saran wrap and then transfer the specimen from the saran wrap to a clean specimen container. It is also acceptable to collet a stool swab from an infant. You must obtain the swab from the laboratory in advance.
- 3. For toddlers, do not take specimens out of a potty bowl. You may line the in saran wrap and then transfer the specimen from the saran wrap to a clean specimen container.
- 4. Label specimens with first and last name, date of birth, and time and date of collection. Return the specimen to the laboratory within one hour of collection, or refrigerate immediately.
