RE: Pap smears

Dear providers,

Pap Smears will return to the SJ/C Laboratory in-house test menu on July 29, 2024. The ThinPrep liquid-based technique will be utilized for Pap smear testing. HPV and CT/NG testing can be performed on ThinPrep gynecological specimens for patient convenience.

PAP testing results will be available via the patient's EMR under Diagnostics/Pathology.

To ensure timely processing of Pap specimens, please consider the following:

- A Cytology order requested by a Licensed Independent Practitioner (LIP) is required.
 - All specimens must be accompanied by a completed requisition if required information is not included in the LIP order.
- The requisition must include:
 - o The patient's name,
 - o The patient's date of birth,
 - o The submitting physician's name,
 - o The specimen type (source),
 - o If the specimen is for an outpatient, additional requirements include:
 - The patient's social security number
 - The patient's address
 - The billing information to include appropriate diagnosis codes.
- Two patient identifiers must be on the specimen container.
- Other helpful information to include on the requisition:
 - LMF
 - History and other pertinent clinical information, to include history of abnormal Pap, hormone therapy or hysterectomy.
