Re: SPECIMEN TRANSPORT CONTAINER CHANGE - OVA & PARASITE EXTENDED EXAM

Beginning 5/15/2023, the collection container for Ova & Parasite Extended Exam (LAB955) will change to AlcorFix Parasep SF (green-capped) transport.

Collection Instructions: Transfer 2g stool w/in one hour of collection into AlcorFix







Total Fix Vial

PVA 10% Formalin

Also acceptable

- One Total-Fix (black-capped) vial: Transfer 10 g stool into Total Fix vial
- One 10% Formalin vial combined with one PVA vial (pink/blue capped): Transfer 5g stool w/in one hour of collection into each of a 10% formalin vial and a modified PVA vial (10g total). (Min: 10g total)

UNACCEPTABLE SPECIMEN: Samples preserved in SAF (yellow-capped)

NOTE: This change only affects Ova & Parasite Extended exam (LAB955).

Continue to collect SAF (yellow-capped) transport for Ova & Parasite <u>Basic exam</u>.

AlcorFix, Total Fix, and PVA transports are <u>NOT ACCEPTABLE</u> for use for Ova & Parasite Basic exam (LAB258).
