As of February 20th, the ferritin reference range for females will be adjusted to more closely reflect a physiologic basis. This change will help identify more women at risk for iron deficiency.

The current reference range for ferritin in females is: 13-150 ng/mL. <u>The new reference range for ferritin in females is: 30-150 ng/mL.</u>
