**Source: Tissue** 

When placing an order for joint fluid crystal analysis, tissue has been removed as a source. The only acceptable specimen source is joint fluid. If a tissue specimen must be submitted for crystal analysis, please use lab order LAB 8008 Pathology Tissue request and in the order, indicate specimen is to rule out gout.

**Specimen stability is 24 hours.** Refrigeration will slow the decomposition of the tissue.

**Unacceptable specimens: Tissues** submitted in saline or formalin. Any aqueous solution will dissolve the urate crystals and make it impossible to see under the microscope.
