# **Laboratory Testing Update**

Effective Tuesday July 8, 2025, the laboratory will be moving to a new collection and testing platform for Vaginitis testing, the **Hologic Aptima Multi-test tube collection kit.** The BD Molecular Swab collection kit and testing platform will no longer be available after July 7, 2025.

The laboratory is also pleased to offer a one swab collection option for Vaginitis and STI testing on Vaginal sources using the Aptima Multi-test tube collection kit: Vaginitis and STI panel

#### **Orders**

- Vaginitis Panel: LAB1757
  - o Bacterial vaginosis (BV) including Lactobacillus (*L. gasseri, L. crispatus, and L. jensenii*), *Gardnerella vaginalis*, and *Atopobium vaginae*.
  - o Trichomonas vaginosis
  - o Candida species group (C. albicans, C. tropicalis, C. parapsilosis, C. dubliniensis)
  - Candida glabrata

### Vaginitis and STI Panel

- Bacterial vaginosis
- o Trichomonas vaginosis
- o Candida species and Candida glabrata
- o Chlamydia trachomatis
- Neisseria gonorrheae
- o Mycoplasma genitalium

#### **Collection and Specimen Source**

- Female
- Clinician-collected or Patient-collected (in a clinical setting)
- Vaginal swab specimens
- Collection kit: (Hologic) Aptima Multi-test Swab
- Unacceptable: male, any source other than vaginal
  - Current order options for Chlamydia/GC, Trichomonas, and *Mycoplasma genitalium* will remain available for collections on males and for any other sources
