

24 Hour Urine Specimen Collection

Collection Instructions:

- 1. Label container with:
 - Patient Name
 - Date of Birth
 - Start Collection Date and Time
 - End Collection Date and Time (the last time your collected a sample)
- 2. Void the first urine and flush the sample. All urine after this urine will be collected.
- 3. Place collection container on the bowl of the toilet, under the seat.
- 4. After sample has been obtained, pour the urine into the 24 hour container.
- 5. Specimen must be refrigerated or kept in a container of ice to avoid bacteria growth and sample degradation which can cause inaccurate results.
- 6. For 24 hours, repeat steps 4 through 6 to collect all urine.
- 7. The last sample should be the first morning urine at the end of the 24 hour period.
- 8. Deliver specimen to St Peter's Main Lab within 24 hours of collection for accurate results.
- 9. Bring any paper orders the doctor gave you.

St Pete's Main Lab Directions:

- 1. Enter St. Peter's Hospital through Emergency Room entrance.
- 2. Walk straight past registration desks and through the double doors.
- 3. Lab is the first door on the left after the tile changes to carpet at the double doors. Look for BIO-HAZARD sign on door
- 4. Please ring doorbell and someone will be with you to receive your sample.
