Not sure which swabs are used for what? No problem! Here's your answer:



GENERAL SWAB

- 1. Rapid Group Strep A (throat)
- 2. Culture MRSA (NOT PCR)
- 3. Culture Throat
- 4. Culture Group B Strep (C GBS)
- 5. Wet Prep (Vaginal Pathogens)



ESWAB IS FOR WOUND, ANAEROBIC/AEROBIC & GENITAL CULTURES

WHITE CAP, clear liquid

Note: Do not use swab for sterile body fluids and aspirates. Eswab also can be used for general aerobic cultures.

GeneXpert collection kit: Chlamydia/Gonorrhea, Endocervical or Vaginal


YELLOW CAP, clear liquid

Urine (yellow top tube, clear liquid) for males and females are also acceptable.



<u>PINK</u>CAP, clear liquid For female collection <u>only</u>. Do NOT collect on males.
