Explanation: The volatile screen detects and quantifies methanol, ethanol, isopropanol, and acetone in biological samples. Although urine is considered a non-invasive sample type, the concentration of the volatile compounds do not correlate with the level of consumption or degree of intoxication. Urine is also susceptible to contamination and dilution.

The urine volatile screen will be discontinued on the effective date.
