#### Interpretation:

AMH can serve as a surrogate for antral follicle count (AFC) on days 2 to 4 of the menstrual cycle to assess ovarian reserve. It should be used in conjunction with other clinical and laboratory findings before starting fertility therapy. Women who are menopausal or have premature ovarian failure, including those who have undergone cancer chemotherapy, typically exhibit very low AMH levels.
